1. Version History

First version is B1.0

Form firmware B1.0 to B1.2 (B1.1 does not exist)

- Improved writing quality on some DVD+R media.

Changes from firmware B1.2 to B1.3

- Improved recognition of copied DVD discs.
- Corrected write speed shown in CDSpeed.
- Improved reading of table of contents on DVD-R and DVD-RW.
- InCD can now format new DVD+RW discs.
- Improved writing quality on some DVD+R and DVD+RW media.

Changes from firmware B1.3 to B1.4

- Playing of recorded DVD+R Double Layer discs is added

Changes from firmware B1.4 to B1.5

- Released 12 August 2005.
- Improved writing quality on unknown DVD+R and DVD+RW media by using an improved algorithm.
